Do I Need to be Catholic?

You do not have to be Catholic to attend St. Mary's. If, like us, you are committed to the holistic education of your child and support the ideal of an inclusive community, you are warmly welcomed at St. Mary's.

How much are the tuition fees?

To provide a quality education we rely on Government funding, and fees and levies from parents.

Tuition fees at St. Mary's are very affordable; from as little as \$48.50 per week (for one child, over a 52-week year) and if you require assistance, please chat to us. As a Catholic Parish school, we encourage and welcome conversations with families who may need financial assistance in order to meet fees.

How important is NAPLAN?

NAPLAN is a 'snapshot' of your child's education from only four occasions in their entire primary and secondary journey. St. Mary's NAPLAN results reflect the state average in all Year 3 and Year 5 areas. Whilst it may be an important diagnostic tool for some, it does not show the intrinsic talents of each student. What NAPLAN *isn't* able to test is whether your child is a gifted musician, great at sports, an innovative, creative artist, and a caring and considerate friend to their classmates.

Your child's semester reports and regular feedback form St. Mary's teachers remain the most comprehensive measure of their achievements.

All children are unique and our challenge is to ensure that, with our proven teaching philosophies and your support, they will grow spiritually, academically, socially and physically during their time at St. Mary's.

What comes after Primary School?

If you are considering a Catholic secondary school, your child's educational and spiritual experiences at St. Mary's ensures this will be a seamless transition. We are proud to partner with Catholic secondary school, McAuley College, to offer an exceptional Prep-to-Year-12 education to Beaudesert families.
