Sibling Rates

Additional Charges

Textbooks will be invoiced in Term 1 for relevant year level. Year 5 and Year 6 camps will be invoiced in instalments. Swimming will be invoiced during the relevant term.

Tuition Fee

Tuition Fees ensure the operational cost of the school are met. Sibling rates apply to the Tuition Fee for families with more than one child enrolled.

Capital Levy

The Capital Levy will enable St. Mary's to continue to develop. The levy contributes to upgrading buildings and structures. The Capital Levy is a family-based levy.

Student Levy

The Student Levy covers excursions, incursions and classroom resources. It also includes an Archdiocesan Education Levy, which provides shared resources to all schools across the Archdiocese. This Student Levy also covers subscription costs for students (camps are not included in this levy).

The IT Levy will ensure our students are provided with the latest technology equipment, data access, resources and support.
